



White-Hall Park

Near the start of the trail, a wooden bridge crosses over the abutments of a former trolley trestle span from the abandoned Norwich & Westerly Railway. The trail winds around small ponds before continuing through open fields and into rocky uplands. Take a seat in the large, natural stone throne or visit the high ledge overlook that is best viewed in winter.
